process, the company crafts clean label plant-based products, selling them to over 30 countries worldwide. Two years after
joining the North America Business Unit as an intern, I oversaw the region's P&L and \$2M budget with the goal of increasing
market share while ensuring financial viability.

Strategy and Operations

- Developed the area's business plan, forecasted sales, managed the distribution network, and controlled spend.
- Decreased monthly closure process by 8 hours by automating inventory tracking through an Excel dashboard and GL Accounts mapping through a new expense management tool.
- Increased product margins by 7% by developing a new distribution network that sells directly to domestic distributors or end clients and reduces supply chain layers, as we transitioned away from selling to one major go-to distributor.
- Increased 1H2023 top-line by 368% and improved bottom-line by 63% vs same period YAGO by closing new clients (Retail & Food Service), creating a tiered pricing structure based on distribution models, and carefully managing the region's OPEX.
